### Fall '24 Session

- July 15-August 5: Open registration via email first come first served basis.
  - New students: \$35 (covers siblings if registered at the same time)
  - Returning students: \$25 (covers siblings if registered at the same time)
    - Please note registration **will not** be accepted until July 17 via email ([ben@themovementstudiopv.com](mailto:ben@themovementstudiopv.com)) in the order it's received.
    - Please provide the student's full name, DOB, day/time/name of class(es) you wish to enroll.
    - Please be certain before sending email as any changes will bring you back to the bottom of the list and incur a \$5 changing fee per class.
- Monday, August 5: Fall Session begins and ends December 20
- Labor Day- Monday, September 2: STUDIO OPEN FOR DANCE
- Fall Break- Monday, October 7-Saturday, October 12: STUDIO CLOSED FOR DANCE
- Halloween - Thursday, October 31: Studio CLOSED
- Thanksgiving Break- Wednesday, November 27-Saturday, November 30: STUDIO CLOSED FOR DANCE
- **COSTUME FEE DEPOSIT**- If you plan to continue in the Spring Session and perform in our Spring Showcase (June 7, 2025) please pay for ONE costume fee deposit **DUE November 15th**. (Please see **Costume Fees** for totals under "Spring Session")

## Winter '24 Showcase

- Join us for our *optional* Themed Winter Showcase to end our Fall Dance session, Saturday, December 14th at the PV Civic Center Amphitheater (Theater on the Green) at 12pm!
  - There will NOT be expensive dance costumes for this show. We order holiday shirts to unite everyone. Parents will provide “costuming” such as shirts (our holiday shirt), black leggings, or simple leotards and tights with accessories like scarves or hats (as directed by their dance teacher).
  - There may be additional (optional) performance opportunities such as Acker Night, PV Holiday Light Parade, PV Winter Spectacular, Prescott Parade, etc that we will invite our classes to so be on the lookout!
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## Spring '25 Session

- Dancers continuing from Fall Session *only*: Free registration
- Spring Registration: \$35 (covers siblings if registered at the same time)
- Monday, January 6: Spring Season begins (ends June 7)
- **Spring Showcase *remaining* Costume Fees due: January 15**, \$75+tax (\$81.89) or \$88+tax (\$96.08) per costume. No refunds.
  - Late fee: \$5 for EACH costume after January 15
  - Late fee: \$10 for EACH costume after February 15
  - Late fee: \$15 for EACH costume after March 15
- Spring Break- Monday, March 17-Saturday, 22: STUDIO CLOSED FOR DANCE
- **Recital Fee**- \$50 *per dancer* due: April 15 (includes 2 Showcase tickets)
- Memorial Day- Monday, May 26: STUDIO CLOSED

## Attendance/Safety Precautions

All students are expected to attend all scheduled classes during the season unless there is a reasonable excuse. Please contact the instructor via phone, text, or Facebook Messenger if the student will be late or absent. If a student misses 3 consecutive classes, a 30 minute private lesson will be required. If the student misses 6 or more classes in a session they will need to schedule 1-2 hour long private lessons. Regular attendance is vital to the success of your child and their class!

Obviously, it is important for your child to STAY HOME if they are feeling under the weather (ie, cough, runny nose, stomach ache, fever). We take pride in keeping our studio clean and sanitized. We ask that our dancers use the restroom BEFORE class to limit interruptions. Also, parent viewing inside the studio is CLOSED with the exception of Tiny Tots Dance & Ballet/Jazz/Tumble Tots, and by the discretion of the teacher. Our lobby in the main studio is at a capacity of 10 people so we ask that you do not congregate when we are at capacity. Also, dancers are not allowed to bring friends to class to watch. If they would like to participate they will need a parent to bring them in and sign a waiver form beforehand to participate in a trial class.

# Conduct & Code

We have high expectations of our dancers (and parents). Dance is a fun and beautiful art form and we *highly* encourage exploration, growth, and FUN! We also want the time spent in the studio to be beneficial and worthwhile to everyone and believe that proper conduct is key to a successful learning environment. Therefore, we expect the following “code” from our dancers:

**HONESTY-** Always be true to yourself and not sell yourself short. The word “can’t” is not allowed in class. You are far more capable than you believe possible. Be honest to yourself and others and allow your teachers to help you own up to your fullest potential!

**COURTESY-** Please arrive on time (5 minutes early) to class, dressed and prepared mentally and physically to learn! Listen with intent to your instructors so you may get the very best experience out of every class.

**RESPECT-** Always honor yourself and others by treating each other in a friendly and encouraging way. No negative self-talk or talking badly about others. Respect the personal space of those around you. Also, respect your studio! Please pick up after yourself and help others when needed.

**DISCIPLINE-** We are here to train, learn, and grow! Improvement comes with *hard work*, *consistency* and *dedication*. If you are having a bad day, we guarantee DANCE will make it better!

# DRESS CODE

*Dress code is enforced at the teacher’s discretion. Multiple violations could result in the student being asked to sit out of class. Please come to class prepared to dance! Be sure to check our used dance shoe bins for FREE shoes if needed!*

**Tiny Tot Dance (ages 2-3) and Tiny Ballet/Tap classes (ages 2-4):** Leotard (any color) and tights or leggings (footless), and pink ballet slippers. Any combo class with tap will need black tap shoes. Hair must be securely tied back away from the face.

**Pre-Ballet, Preschool Ballet, Ballet Combo classes (ages 2.5-7):** Any color leotard, pink tights, and pink ballet shoes. Hair must be in a bun or pulled back best you can.

**Acro:** Leotard or unitard (any color), footless tights, spandex shorts, or leggings. Hair must be securely tied back away from the face in a ponytail.

**Little Dancers, Jazz/Tumble (ages 5-7) and Mini Jazz (ages 4-9):** Active/dancewear that is form fitting (i.e. leggings, leotards, tank tops). Tan jazz shoes -black jazz shoes for boys. Hair must be securely tied back away from the face.

**Hip Hop:** Sweatpants/comfortable pants that are easy to move in (no jeans or jeggings), tank top or shirt (sports bra under for girls), and sneakers. No bra tops. Hats may be worn.

**Jazz (Beg, Int, Adv)/Contemporary:** Any color leotard or tight fitting top, leggings, spandex, tights with Softe shorts, or any other appropriate fitted dance attire. Tan jazz shoes, Foot Undeez, or Apollo Shocks. Hair must be securely tied back away from the face in a ponytail or bun.

**Lyrical:** Leotard (black preferred), leggings, spandex, tights with Softe shorts, or any other appropriate fitted dance attire. Must wear Foot Undeez, pirouette shoes, or Apollo Shocks- NO BARE FEET. Hair must be securely tied back away from the face in a ponytail or bun.

**Ballet (Level I-IV):** BLACK leotard, PINK tights, and PINK ballet shoes. NO EXCEPTIONS. Hair must be up in a bun. A ballet skirt (preferably black) is optional for Pointe ONLY.

**Tap (all):** Any color leotard or tight fitting top or t-shirt, dance shorts with tights, or leggings. Hair needs to be securely tied back away from the face. See tap instructor for tap shoe recommendations.

\*NO shorts without tights or spandex on in ANY dance class\*

\*NO GUM or FOOD in ANY of the dance studios\*

\*Please bring a reusable LABELED water bottle! Water is available for \$1\*

\*PLEASE be sure your LITTLE dancer has used the restroom BEFORE class begins! Thank you!\*

## PLEASE NOTE:

- Costume fee does NOT include extra mandatory costume pieces that may be needed such as tights, body tights, specific dance shoes, tan bandeau bra with clear straps, etc.
- Recital Fees and Costume Fees are **non-refundable**.
- We do not offer make-up classes or pro-rate for missed or canceled classes. We offer low rates each month taking all studio closure dates throughout the session into account.
- In the event you wish to withdraw from a dance class, written cancellation must be given by the 5th of the month via email in order to avoid being charged for the following month (billing date falls on the 15th of each month).
